We also have some opportunities for just the 55 Plus:

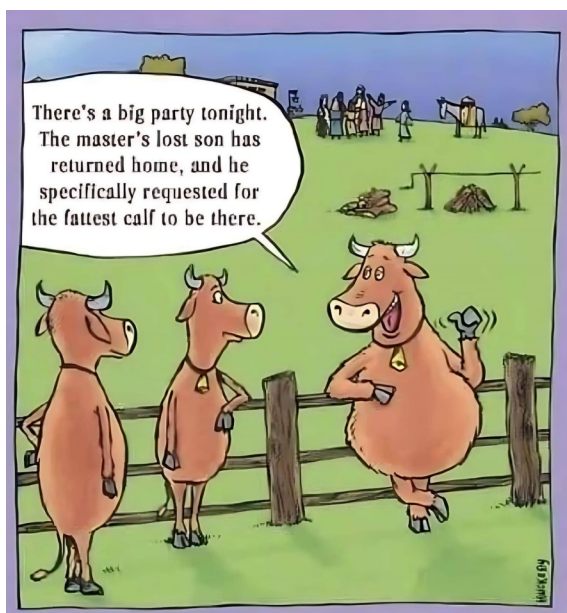
- ♦ The Drumheller group leaves on July 9th for a trip, with the highlight being the Passion Play.

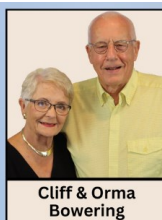

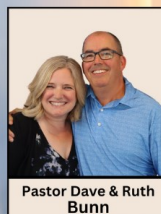
